The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S. 131E-184(g). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop, or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

Re: Notice of Exempt Capital Expenditure Pursuant to NCGS § 131E-184(g) for Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center (NHPMC) Women's & Pediatrics Unit Renovations; FID # 943501 / Mecklenburg County

Dear Ms. Pittman:

This letter outlines Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center's (NHPMC's) project to renovate and update its existing women's services and pediatric units on the 7th Floor and the 2th floor, respectively in the main building on the Charlotte campus. The project cost is estimated to exceed \$2 million and is exempt from Certificate of Need (CON) review by the CON Section for the reasons set forth in this letter. The estimated total capital costs for this project are approximately \$5,300,000.

This project is exempt from CON review and meets the criteria set forth in NCGS § 131E-184(g) as follows:

1. The sole purpose of the capital expenditure is to renovate, replace on the same site, or expand the entirety or a portion of an existing health service facility that is located on the main campus;

This project is to relocate 6 existing licensed beds in Women's Services on the 7th floor to the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) on the 2nd floor as licensed beds. This will expand the capacity of intermediate care for pediatric services. The vacated rooms on the 7th floor are to be renovated and converted to 4 unlicensed Labor & Delivery rooms.

The project takes place at Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center, 200 Hawthorne Lane, Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina. The location on Hawthorne Lane is the "main campus" for NHPMC as it is the site from which NHPMC "provides clinical patient services and exercises financial and administrative control over the entire facility." 2. The capital expenditure does not result in (i) a change in bed capacity as defined in GS 131E-176(5) or (ii) the addition of a health service facility or any other new institutional health service facility or any other new institutional health service other than that allowed in GS 131E-176(16)b.;

The renovations of the 7th floor area and 2nd floor PICU will not result in a change in bed capacity or in the addition of a health service facility or any other new institutional health service facility. The space is to be renovated and updated in its current location in the main hospital.

3. The licensed health service facility proposing to incur the capital expenditure shall provide prior written notice to the Department along with supporting documentation to demonstrate it meets the exemption criteria of this subsection.

This correspondence and supporting documentation serves as the required notice to the CON Section that the Women's and Pediatric Services renovation project meets the exemption criteria.

In conclusion, based on the information described above, please confirm that NHPMC's project to renovate and update the 7th floor Women's Services and 2nd floor PICU fits within the exemption requirements at NCGS § 131E-184(g), therefore making it exempt from CON review.
