Dear Ms. Gunter:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that the above referenced project is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S. 131E-184(a)(7). Therefore, you may proceed to bring in and operate, without a certificate of need, one mobile MRI scanner, to temporarily replace one of the fixed MRI scanners licensed under Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center that is currently undergoing emergency repairs. This determination is based on your representations that the mobile MRI scanner will be brought into North Carolina only for the duration of the repairs, will be removed from North Carolina once repairs to the fixed MRI scanner are complete, and will not be used again in the State without first obtaining a certificate of need if one is required.

It should be noted that the Agency's position is based solely on the facts represented by you and that any change in facts as represented would require further consideration by this office and a separate determination. Good morning and Happy Friday, Celia and Gloria,

I am writing with an emergency request for Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center. NHFMC has three fixed MRI scanners. One of the three is down for replacement. Just today, one of the remaining two scanners experienced a malfunction that will take it out of service for at least a week because a part has to be ordered from Siemens in Germany, and when the part arrives in the U.S., it will need to go through customs which will mean some delay. We estimate that the process to obtain the part will take at least one week. Novant proposes to bring in an out of state mobile MRI scanner during this time so that NHFMC can maintain service with two scanners. When the disabled scanner is repaired, Novant will remove the mobile and take it out of state. Scan volume at NHFMC continues to be very strong, with the scanners going 7 days a week, so going down to 1 scanner even for a short time is not possible.

May we proceed to implement this solution while the unit undergoes repair? I apologize for presenting this via an email but due to the urgent nature, I wanted to act as quickly as possible.

Thanks in advance for your consideration of this request. I'm glad to answer any questions you may have.
