Dear Mr. Shaw:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) determined that the project described above is exempt from certificate of need (CON) review in accordance with G.S. 131E-184(a)(8). Therefore, the above referenced business may proceed to acquire the health service facility identified above without first obtaining a CON. The Agency's determination is limited to the question of whether the above referenced business would have to obtain a CON if the current owners of the health service facility do in fact sell it to the business listed above. Note that pursuant to G.S. 131E-181(b): "A recipient of a certificate of need, or any person who may subsequently acquire, in any manner whatsoever permitted by law, the service for which that certificate of need was issued, is required to materially comply with the representations made in its application for that certificate of need."

If the business listed above does acquire the facility, you should contact the Agency's Acute and Home Care Licensure and Certification Section to obtain instructions for changing ownership and operator of the existing facility.

It should be noted that this Agency's position is based solely on the facts represented by you and that any change in facts as represented would require further consideration by this Agency and a separate determination regarding whether a certificate of need would be required. Dear Ms. Mitchell, Ms. Hale, and Ms. Inman:

Our firm represents Peters Endoscopy Center, LLC ("Peters Endoscopy"). This letter is to notify you of a proposed transaction whereby Peters Endoscopy will acquire ownership of an existing endoscopy center in Surry County. Peters Endoscopy hereby requests a letter, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(8), determining that a change of ownership for an existing endoscopy center is exempt from Certificate of Need ("CON") review.

A. The Proposed Transaction

Peters Endoscopy, a North Carolina limited liability company, has entered into a proposed transaction (the "Transaction") with Dr. Glenn Pfizer, owner of Rockford Digestive Health Endoscopy Center, PA, FID: 130325 ("Rockford"), at 951 Rockford St., Mount Airy, NC 27030, to sell Rockford's endoscopy center, including its CON license, to Peters Endoscopy. Both Peters Endoscopy and Rockford are existing health service facilities within the meaning of the CON law—they are ambulatory surgical facilities. G.S. §§ 131E-176(9b); (1b); 10A NCAC 14C .3901(4). Rockford has represented it is AAAHC accredited. Rockford obtained a CON from the State of North Carolina, License Number: AS0154, issued January 11, 2014.

Peters Endoscopy will become the new owner and operator of the Rockford center, but the location and health services offered will remain the same. adversely impact the patient population. Rockford is currently the only outpatient non-hospital based endoscopy center in Surry County, according to 2021 State Medical Facilities Plan. Peters Endoscopy will continue to operate the center in the same way, serving the same patient population in the same service area. 10A NCAC 14C .3901(6).

The Transaction is expected to close on November 1, 2021.

B. <u>Exemption Notice</u>

Under North Carolina law, a CON is required prior to offering or developing a "new institutional health service," unless the facility or project is exempted. Though the "purchase, lease, or acquisition of any health service facility, or portion thereof, or a controlling interest in the health service facility or portion thereof, if the health service facility was developed under a certificate of need issued pursuant to G.S. 131E-180" is included in the definition of "new institutional health services," G.S. 131E-176(16)(l), G.S. 131E-184(a)(8) specifically exempts acquisitions of "an existing health service facility, including equipment owned by the health service facility at the time of acquisition" from CON review.

The Transaction will consist of the acquisition of an existing health service facility, including substantially all of the assets owned by the health service facility at the time of acquisition. The Transaction will not result in the construction, development, establishment, increase in number, or relocation of a gastrointestinal endoscopy room. G.S. 131E-176(16)(u). The Transaction does not include the purchase of any additional equipment. G.S. 131E-176(140), (16)(f1). The Transaction also will not include the offering of any additional health services. G.S. 131E-176(16)(f). We therefore believe that the Transaction is statutorily exempted from CON review.

Accordingly, we are notifying you of the Transaction, and we respectfully request a letter from the CON Section stating that the Transaction is exempt from CON review in accordance with G.S. § 131E-184(a)(8). Please let me know if there are any questions regarding this notice, or if you need any additional information.
