Dear Ms. Cummer:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that the above referenced project is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S. 131E-184(7). Therefore, you may proceed to utilize without a certificate of need the existing research CT scanner (designated as C3) to temporarily replace the GE Lightspeed CT scanner in the emergency department. This determination is based on your representations that the existing C3 CT scanner will be designated as a research scanner following installation of the permanent replacement CT scanner and will not be used again in the State without first obtaining a certificate of need if one is required.

It should be noted that the Agency's position is based solely on the facts represented by you and that any change in facts as represented would require further consideration by this office and a separate determination. ### Dear Mike,

I am writing to you in your capacity as team leader and in follow up to a conversation that I believe we had last year about using research equipment as temporary replacements while regular equipment is out of service.

As set forth in <a href="https://info.ncdhhs.gov/dhsr/coneed/reviews/2022/may/3892-Durham-Duke-University-Hospital-943138-Exemption.pdf">https://info.ncdhhs.gov/dhsr/coneed/reviews/2022/may/3892-Durham-Duke-University-Hospital-943138-Exemption.pdf</a>, DUH received an exemption for the replacement of a CT scanner in the emergency department. We have a CT scanner that is regularly used only for research purposes designated internally as C3; however, to ensure sufficient capacity to meet patient needs during the permanent replacement, we would like use the C3 scanner as a temporary

replacement during the approximately four months that the ED scanner will be out of service for the replacement. Upon the completion of ED CT replacement, we may be reaching out to you about using the same machine temporarily during another planned replacement (which will be the subject of an exemption notice).

The use of the C3 scanner during this replacement period for clinical scans will not involve any capital expenditure.

Can you let me know if we can proceed on this? To the extent necessary, can this be notice of an exempt acquisition? There is some urgency as it turns out the existing CT will be taken out of service to start the replacement on Friday. Thank you very much.
