Dear Emily Cromer:

The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S. 131E-184(a)(4). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

Re: Rex Hospital, Inc.'s Exemption Notice Regarding New Parking Deck and Chiller Relocation and Expansion

Dear Ms. Mitchell and Mr. McKillip:

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(4), Rex Hospital, Inc. ("UNC Rex") gives this prior written notice of a proposed exempt project. UNC Rex is planning to construct a new parking deck and to relocate and expand the existing chiller plant on the UNC Rex main campus located at 4420 Lake Boone Trail in Raleigh, North Carolina. See Exhibit 1. The new parking deck and expanded chiller plant are needed to support the planned construction of a CON-exempt bed tower on UNC Rex's main campus pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(g).¹

This planned project (the "Exempt Project") falls within the provisions in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(4), which exempts projects "[t]o provide parking, heating or cooling systems, elevators, or other basic plant or mechanical improvements, unless these activities are integral portions of a project that involves the construction of a new health service facility or portion thereof and that is subject to certificate of need review."

In accordance with Section 131E-184(a)(4), the sole purpose of the project is to provide parking and heating or cooling systems. As noted above, the Exempt Project is an integral portion of UNC Rex's CON-exempt construction of a new bed tower on UNC Rex's main campus pursuant to G.S. 131E-184(g). As such, the Exempt Project is not related to any project that is subject to certificate of need review.

Finally, in accordance with Section 131E-184(a), this correspondence serves as prior written notice to the Agency of UNC Rex's planned Exempt Project.

¹ UNC Rex is submitting a separate Main Campus Exemption notice regarding the planned bed tower construction pursuant to G.S. 131E-184(g).

Conclusion

It is our understanding and belief that all aspects of this project to construct a new parking deck and to relocate and expand the existing chiller plant on UNC Rex's main campus are exempt from CON review pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(4), and UNC Rex requests written confirmation of such understanding. 
