Dear Ms. Mitchell and Mr. Yakaboski:

Please accept this letter as notification that CarolinaEast Medical Center (CEMC) is renovating and upfitting a building located at 640 McCarthy Boulevard, New Bern, North Carolina to be used as a medical office building (MOB). Both the building and land are owned by CEMC, and the site is the former location of a diagnostic center, the equipment from which has previously been relocated to the main campus of CEMC¹. The MOB will provide a new location and additional space for physicians and their patients in New Bern. No new institutional health services will be offered in the building without first obtaining a Certificate of Need.

Based upon the project as described above, and pursuant to N.C. GEN. STAT. § 131E-184(a)(9), the project is exempt from Certificate of Need review. This letter serves as notification of our intent to proceed with this project. We are requesting that you confirm in writing that this project is exempt from Certificate of Need review.
