The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency), determined that the above referenced proposal is exempt from certificate of need review in accordance with G.S. 131E-184(g). Therefore, you may proceed to offer, develop or establish the above referenced project without a certificate of need.

It should be noted that this determination is binding only for the facts represented by you. Consequently, if changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in your correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by the Agency. Changes in a project include but are not limited to: (1) increases in the capital cost; (2) acquisition of medical equipment not included in the original cost estimate; (3) modifications in the design of the project; (4) change in location; and (5) any increase in the number of square feet to be constructed.

Re: Notice of Exempt Renovation Activities at Duke University Hospital

Dear Ms. Mitchell:

The purpose of this letter is to provide written notice of planned renovation activities on the Duke University Hospital main campus that will cost in excess of the capital cost threshold for a new institutional health service established in G.S. 131E-176(16)b. The project includes the renovation of space in the Duke North bed tower. That tower opened in 1980 and its patient rooms are in need of upgrades to electrical connections, plumbing, airflow systems, data cabling, and cosmetics. In addition to cosmetic upgrades on floors two through four of the tower, the renewal work will consist of replacing outdated plumbing, HVAC ductwork, IT wiring, and normal and emergency power, replacing tubs with showers, and updating lighting with LED fixtures throughout the tower.

Section 131E-184(g) provides that "The Department shall exempt from certificate of need review any capital expenditure that exceeds the monetary threshold set forth in G.S. 131E-176(16)b. if all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The sole purpose of the capital expenditure is to renovate, replace on the same site, or expand the entirety or a portion of an existing health service facility that is located on the main campus.
- (2) The capital expenditure does not result in (i) a change in bed capacity as defined in G.S. 131E-176(5) or (ii) the addition of a health service facility or any other new institutional health service other than that allowed in G.S. 131E-176(16)b.
- (3) The licensed health service facility proposing to incur the capital expenditure shall provide prior written notice to the Department, along with supporting G.S. 131E-184 documentation to demonstrate that it meets the exemption criteria of this subsection."

As set forth below, we believe that Duke University Hospital's project is exempt from certificate of need review.

(1) <u>Main Campus</u>

The purpose of this project is facility renovation on the "main campus" of Duke University Hospital, a licensed hospital. The "main campus" of the facility is defined in N.C.G.S. 131E-176(14n) to include both "[t]he site of the main building from which a licensed health service facility provides clinical patient services and exercises financial and administrative control over the entire facility, including the buildings and grounds adjacent to that main building" and "[o]ther areas and structures that are not strictly contiguous to the main building but are located within 250 yards of the main building." In this case, Duke University Hospital is a licensed health service facility, and the main hospital building from which Duke University Hospital provides its clinical services and exercises financial and administrative control is the physically contiguous structure that includes Duke South, Duke North (where this project will be implemented), the Duke Children's Hospital, the Duke Medical Pavilion, the Duke Central Tower, the Morris Clinic, the Duke Cancer Center, the Wadsworth Building, and the Hudson Building.

(2) No New Institutional Health Services

The sole purpose of the project at this time is to renovate a portion of the existing health service facility to accommodate existing services. This project will not change Duke's existing bed capacity or inventory of regulated assets or otherwise constitute any other new institutional health service.

(3) <u>Prior Written Notice</u>

Please let this letter serve as the required prior written notice of this project.
