The Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section, Division of Health Service Regulation (Agency) received your correspondence regarding the project described above. Based on the representation in your request and the CON law **in effect on the date of this response to your request**, the project as described is not governed by, and therefore, does not currently require a certificate of need. If the CON law is subsequently amended such that the above referenced proposal would require a certificate of need, this determination does not authorize you to proceed to develop the above referenced proposal when the new law becomes effective.

This determination is binding only for the facts represented in your correspondence. If changes are made in the project or in the facts provided in the correspondence referenced above, a new determination as to whether a certificate of need is required would need to be made by this office. As a reminder, it is unlawful to offer or develop a new institutional health service without first obtaining a certificate of need. The Department reserves the right to impose sanctions, including civil penalties and the revocation of a license, upon any entity that offers or develops a new institutional health service without first obtaining a certificate of need.

Dear Mike and Tanya,

Liberty Home Care II, LLC d/b/a Liberty Home Care and Hospice, is a Medicare-certified hospice agency serving North Carolina patients from its location at 119 W. Wade Street, Wadesboro, NC, 28170, in Anson County.

We are writing to seek confirmation that a Certificate of Need ("CON") is not necessary for our agency to extend hospice home care services to patients residing in Mecklenburg, Cabarrus, and Stanley Counties.

Hospice home care services are essential for patients requiring hospice care outside of traditional inpatient facilities, such as their private residences, nursing homes, or hospitals. Liberty Home Care and Hospice seeks to extend these services to individuals in Mecklenburg, Cabarrus, and Stanley County.

Upon thorough examination of relevant North Carolina statutes, particularly North Carolina General Statute 131E-176(16a), which stipulates a CON requirement for the establishment of new health service facilities, we wish to affirm that Liberty Home Care and Hospice's intended expansion does not fall under this requirement. Furthermore, as per North Carolina General Statute 131E-176(9b), defining a "health service facility," our proposal does not involve the construction or development of a hospice office, hospice inpatient facility, or hospice residential care facility. Instead, our services will be provided from our existing office in Wadesboro, NC.

In light of the above, Liberty Home Care and Hospice respectfully requests the Healthcare Planning and Certificate of Need Section to acknowledge that our agency may extend hospice home care services to residents of Mecklenburg, Cabarrus, and Stanley County.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. We are grateful for your cooperation and understanding as we strive to deliver essential healthcare services to our community.
