Re: MOB Exemption for Scotland Memorial Hospital, Laurinburg, North Carolina (Health Service Area V)

Dear Ms. Mitchell:

On behalf of Scotland Memorial Hospital in Laurinburg, North Carolina, and pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(9), I am writing to provide the Agency with prior written notice of Scotland Memorial Hospital's intention to develop a medical office building ("MOB") at 501 Lauchwood Drive in Laurinburg. Scotland Memorial Hospital will own the MOB. The MOB will be used for office visits with Scotland Memorial Hospital's general surgeons for all of their consults, as well as pre- and post-surgery visits. No new institutional health services, as defined in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-176(16), will be offered or developed in the MOB. The proposed MOB will offer a convenient and accessible location for patients to meet with their surgeons away from the main hospital building.

N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(9) provides that upon prior written notice, the Agency shall exempt from CON review an entity's proposal:

[t]o develop or acquire a physician office building regardless of cost, unless a new institutional health service other than defined in G.S. 131E-176(16)b. is offered or developed in the building.

Scotland Memorial Hospital's proposed MOB meets the requirements of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 131E-184(a)(9). Accordingly, we respectfully request that the Agency confirm that the proposal described in this letter is exempt from CON review.
