


HOW TO CREATE A NCID ACCOUNT

- If you have an existing NCID account, then you do not need to create a new one for the Enterprise System.
- It is recommended that you use either Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome, or Mozilla Firefox web browsers.


To create a NCID account, please complete the steps below.

1. Go to the [North Carolina Identity Management \(NCID\) website](#)
2. In the lower right corner, select “Register!”
