Growth: physical changes in an individual















Development: psychological and/or social functioning of an individual

INFANCY: birth to 1 year old



TODDLERHOOD: 1 to 3 years old



PRESCHOOLERS: 3 to 6 years old



MIDDLE CHILDHOOD: 6 to 8 years old



LATE CHILDHOOD: 9 to 12 years old



ADOLESCENCE: 12 to 18 years old




YOUNG ADULTHOOD: 18 to 40 years old



MIDDLE ADULTHOOD: ages 40 to 65



LATE ADULTHOOD: 65 years and older
