

Need Determination

Application of the standard methodology for the North Carolina 2014 State Medical Facilities Plan determined there is no need for additional Medicare-certified home health agency offices anywhere in the state. There was a need determination for one Medicare-certified home health agency office in Granville County based on Policy HH-3. However, in response to a petition from Granville-Vance District Health Department for an adjusted need determination to remove the one Medicare-certified home health agency office need determination in Granville County, the State Health Coordinating Council approved the request as shown in Table 12D. There is no need anywhere in the state and no other reviews are scheduled.
