## Charge to the SHCC 2016-2017 Operating Room Methodology Workgroup

An Operating Room Workgroup has been appointed by the Chair of the State Health Coordinating Council with the following charge:

- 1. Review the current operating room methodology and assess its appropriateness for determining operating room need in all areas of the state, for both inpatient and outpatient surgery.
  - a. Review changes made to the methodology that were recommended by the 2007 Operating Room Methodology Workgroup and assess their impact.
  - b. Revisit 2007 Workgroup recommendation to change data source from licensure data to billing data (Truven data).
  - c. Review petitions for ORs submitted to DHSR in the past 10 years.
  - d. Gather input from constituencies to understand how the current methodology is working and to identify potential problems.
  - e. Review each variable in the need methodology formula (average hours per procedure, standard hours per OR) and consider whether changes are warranted.
- 2. If changes in the methodology are needed, prepare recommendations to the Acute Care Committee of the SHCC for their deliberations in Spring, 2017, for possible inclusion in the 2018 SMFP.
