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## Policy ICF/IID-4: Transfer of ICF/IID Beds from State Operated Developmental Centers Pursuant to Session Law 1983 House Bill 1395

Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID) beds in state operated developmental centers may be relocated to community facilities pursuant to Session Law 1983 House Bill 1395. The applicant shall include in its certificate of need application a signed written agreement with the Director of the state operated developmental center, the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse in the Department of Health and Human Services, and the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services. Certificate of need applicants shall demonstrate the following in the application:

- 1. The maximum number of beds in the facility upon completion of the project will not exceed 15 beds.
- 2. The projected per diem operating costs are no more than the per diem operating cost in the state operated developmental center.
- 3. All beds transferred from the state operated developmental center pursuant to this policy shall be utilized for a period of at least 12 months for the transfer of clients from the state operated developmental center to the community facility, after which fifty percent (50%) of the transferred beds may be utilized for non-institutional clients.
