I was a patient at Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center in February, 2013 through April, 2013. As the result of sepsis from pneumonia my physicians determined that I needed inpatient rehabilitation services.

I was dismayed to learn that in Mecklenburg County there is only one provider of inpatient rehabilitation services and that I would have to leave the Novant Health system for these services. In addition, I was advised that my admission to the inpatient rehabilitation unit would be delayed several days. While waiting for a bed, the staff at NHPMC took great care of me. I wish we had another choice in Mecklenburg County.

It is my understanding that Novant Health and HealthSouth are submitting an adjusted need determination for new rehabilitation beds in HSA III. I support the expansion of rehabilitation services in the Greater Charlotte Market. If approved, the Petition will increase access for patients currently denied timely care. This project will promote cost-effective approaches, expand access to health care services and encourage quality health care services by providing more efficient health care services to the residents of Mecklenburg County and surrounding counties.
