Re: Novant Health Comments Regarding the OrthoCarolina Petition to Adjust the Charity Care Calculation for North Carolina ASC Demonstration Project

Dear Dr. Ullrich:

Novant Health appreciates the opportunity to comment on the Petition submitted by OrthoCarolina (OC) to adjust the charity care calculation for North Carolina ASC Demonstration Project in the 2018 State Medical Facilities Plan. OC proposes to decrease the "community benefit care" required target to 5% AND to exclude revenue from procedures that do not yet have a Medicare allowable amount or are not currently ASC approved by Medicare from the denominator in calculating the "community benefit care".

Novant Health believes the ASC Demonstration Project should continue as originally proposed and be reviewed at the end of the five-year timeframe, as originally intended. OC's argument is that it is challenging to work with indigent patients. However, nowhere does OC indicate that there is a lack of such patients.

OC states that "When the 7% Community Benefit Care was proposed in late 2008, early 2009, many of the cases that are now capable of being done in an ASC were not even contemplated. The formula was fair and reasonable at that time, as most ASC cases had Medicare allowable rates. That is not so any longer, as many of the cases Mallard Creek performs are absent the Medicare allowable."

Simply said, OC wants to remove patients from the denominator that receive more complex surgical care for which there is no allowable Medicare rate. This typically implies that these cases are healthy, commercially insured patients though OC does not provide any detail regarding the type of patients for whom they are providing "more complex surgical care". If they are healthy commercially insured patients, removing them from the denominator simply makes it easier for OC to "hit the 7% target." How many of these patients are indigent? Do any of these patients have other health complications? How many are Medicaid? What type of after care is needed, and would an indigent or Medicaid patient even have this support at home? How many are Medicare? How much longer do these cases take? Are they taking up time that simpler cases for indigent patients could have utilized?

Without further detail regarding the type of patients currently receiving "more complex surgical care" at Mallard Creek, it is not reasonable to remove them from the denominator of the

equation. If all of these patients are insured patients, removing them from the denominator is contrary to the intent of the original demonstration project, which was to increase quality & safety, value, and access for ALL patients, not just those who can already seek care at an ASC. Therefore, the SHCC should deny this proposed change in the ASC Demonstration Project.

OC also requests that the "Community Benefit Care" percentage be decreased to 5%. However, OrthoCarolina has shown limited evidence of their efforts to serve this community. OC does not mention working with hospitals and emergency departments — areas where many individuals with Medicaid or self-pay continue to seek care. As a provider located in OC's primary service area, Novant Health can confirm that they have not partnered with Novant Health hospitals such as COH and PMC to identify these patient needs, despite our routine recurring meetings between our management teams and requests for OC to continue to serve our indigent populations in Novant Health's emergency departments.

OC provides one short paragraph in their Petition regarding difficulties they have providing access for the underserved. This hardly seems like a reason to lower the standard to which their Demonstration Project is held. Furthermore, no petitions to amend the 7% factor were filed by the other two single specialty demonstration project ASCs in Forsyth and Wake Counties with concerns about the 7% factor. Several questions should be addressed before considering amending the Demonstration Project. Are they working with the Federally Qualified Health Centers? Have they reached out to the hospitals to identify charity care patients in need of orthopedic care? Do they reach out to the hospitals on a routine basis to identify charity care patients appropriate for care in an ASC? Have they reached out to CCNC, the health department, social services? OC provides little detail regarding their efforts to date to achieve the 7% target.

The 7% Community Benefit Care was intended by the state to be a proxy for a certain level of charity/indigent care that was to be provided by a demonstration project single specialty ASC on an annual basis. This ensures that valuable community resources like operating rooms are used to serve the entire community, including those who have difficulty accessing healthcare services. We respectfully request you deny the proposed Petition to preserve the integrity of intent of the Demonstration Project. Thank you for the opportunity to submit our concerns regarding this Petition.
