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Re: UNC Health Pardee's Comment on Henderson County Bed Need

AdventHealth Hendersonville is writing in response to comments submitted by Pardee UNC Health Care concerning the days of care reported for AdventHealth Hendersonville in the Proposed 2026 State Medical Facilities Plan (SMFP). Pardee's comments request that the Agency verify the reported days of care used to generate the acute care bed need determination in Henderson County.

As reflected in prior email correspondence with Agency staff, AdventHealth Hendersonville identified a data discrepancy earlier this year and worked directly with both the Licensure and Healthcare Planning Sections to resolve the matter. The discrepancy has since been addressed and corrected in coordination with the appropriate staff. We appreciate the Agency's attention and responsiveness throughout that process.

Given that this matter has already been resolved through direct communication and collaboration with Agency staff, we believe no further clarification is necessary. We respectfully request that the Agency give no weight to Pardee's comments as they pertain to a resolved issue.
