Re:	Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID)

Based on terminology changes made in <u>Rosa's Law</u> in 2010, Intermediate Care Facilities for Persons with Mental Retardation (ICF/MR) will now reflect nationwide changes and be referred to as Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID).

Rosa's Law amends numerous federal acts and regulations to replace the term "mental retardation" with "intellectual disability".

The final portion of Rosa's Law clarifies that the changes are made: "without any intent to: (1) change the coverage, eligibility, rights, responsibilities, or definitions referred to in the amended provisions; or (2) compel states to change terminology in state laws for individuals covered by a provision amended by this Act."

The North Carolina Division of Health Service Regulation has adopted the change in terminology for all facilities formerly known as Intermediate Care Facilities for Persons with Mental Retardation (ICF/MR). We are currently working on revisions to our website and communication to reflect this change.
