During telephone interview on 1/15/20 the Director stated she owned several dogs that lived inside the facility. Records of the dogs' immunizations were not immediately available for review, but she could provide them to the surveyor via fax. She had carpeting removed and new flooring installed in the facility in the last year. During interview on 1/15/20 the Operations Director stated the facility was the Director's private residence. There was some clutter in the garage. He understood the requirement for the facility to be maintained in a safe, clean, orderly manner and free from offensive odors. He would discuss the requirement with the Director.
