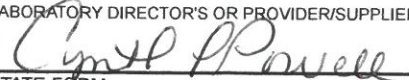

V 118	<p>27G .0209 (C) Medication Requirements</p> <p>10A NCAC 27G .0209 MEDICATION REQUIREMENTS</p> <p>(c) Medication administration:</p> <p>(1) Prescription or non-prescription drugs shall only be administered to a client on the written order of a person authorized by law to prescribe drugs.</p> <p>(2) Medications shall be self-administered by clients only when authorized in writing by the client's physician.</p> <p>(3) Medications, including injections, shall be administered only by licensed persons, or by unlicensed persons trained by a registered nurse, pharmacist or other legally qualified person and privileged to prepare and administer medications.</p> <p>(4) A Medication Administration Record (MAR) of all drugs administered to each client must be kept current. Medications administered shall be recorded immediately after administration. 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V 118	<p>Continued From page 1</p> <p>This Rule is not met as evidenced by: Based on record review, observation and interview, the facility failed to administer medications on the written order of a physician and failed to keep the MARs current affecting one of three audited clients (#5). The findings are:</p> <p>Review on 02/24/2020 of client #5's record revealed: - 42 year old female. - Admission date of 01/13/14. - Diagnoses of Schizophrenia, Paranoid Type, Mild Mental Retardation, Hypercholesterolemia and Sleep Apnea.</p> <p>Review on 02/24/2020 of a signed physician order for client #5 dated 01/14/2020 revealed: - Discontinue Haloperidol 5mg (used to treat schizophrenia) Take 1/2 tablet by mouth at bedtime.</p> <p>Review on 02/24/2020 of client #5's February 2020 MAR revealed: - Haloperidol 5mg Take 1/2 tablet 2.5mg by mouth at bedtime. - Initials on the MAR from 02/01/2020-02/23/2020 that client #5 continued to receive the Haloperidol. - No documentation the Haloperidol was discontinued as ordered.</p> <p>Observation on 02/24/2020 at approximately 11:00am of client #5's medications revealed: - A bubble blister pack labeled for client #5 for Haloperidol dispensed from the pharmacy on</p>	V 118		
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V 118	<p>Continued From page 2</p> <p>02/21/2020.</p> <p>During interview on 02/20/2020 client #5 revealed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -She received her medication daily. -She did not know the names of the medications she took daily. <p>Interview on 02/24/2020 the Licensee revealed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Client #5's doctor wrote medication orders on 01/14/2020 and the orders had mistakes. -The doctor rewrote the orders on 01/15/2020. -Licensee contacted the doctor while surveyor was on-site and the doctor did want the Haloperidol discontinued and notified the doctor of the medication error. -She would inform all the staff of the error and correct the MAR. 	V 118	<p>Finding #1</p> <p>Client #5 Medication Requirements</p> <p><u>Corrective Action/Monitoring/Frequency/Measures</u></p> <p>Staff will ensure that all medications are administered per the order by comparing meds to scripts at the start of each month and at the time medications are received in batch. The Program Manager will check and double check batch items upon receipt to ensure that all medications received are accurate based on the latest scripts and previous MAR. Staff will ensure that any medications discontinued since last batch is identified accordingly and removed from resident's current med stock to be returned to pharmacy.</p> <p><u>Measures to Prevent This from Recurring</u></p> <p>The strict adherence to the above process will prevent errors of this type from reoccurring in the future.</p> <p>The Program Manager will be responsible for checking this at the start of each month and comparing previous month's MAR to the new; making any additions or deletions that may be required.</p> <p>A new pharmacy will be utilized effective May 2020 who appear to have better quality control practices in place than our current one. They also provide, according to what we are told, a rep who will do regular monitoring of medications on hand at the facility. This adds additional oversight to our internal quality control efforts.</p>	3/1/2020
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
