The findings are:</p> <p>Review on 8/17/21 of staff #1's personnel record revealed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Title of Developmental Specialist. - Hire date 7/05/94. - Training in CPR and First Aid dated 10/02/19. <p>During interviews on 8/17/21 and 8/18/21 staff #1 stated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CPR/First Aid training was completed online. - CPR training participants demonstrated chest compressions by clicking a computer mouse. <p>Review on 8/17/21 of staff #2's personnel record revealed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Title of Developmental Specialist. - Hire date 7/20/15. - Training in CPR and First Aid dated 2/23/21. <p>During interview on 8/17/21 staff #2 stated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All training, including CPR and First Aid were completed online. - CPR training participants demonstrated chest compressions by clicking a computer mouse. - "The computer will tell you if your going too fast or too slow." 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V 108	<p>Continued From page 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CPR training participants also demonstrated proficiency with the Automatic External Defibrillator via the computer mouse. <p>Review on 8/17/21 of the Team Leader's personnel record revealed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Title of Team Leader. - Hire date 9/12/05. - Training in CPR and First Aid dated 1/008/20. <p>During interview on 8/18/21 the Team Leader stated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CPR and First Aid training were completed online. - CPR training participants demonstrated chest compressions by clicking a computer mouse. <p>During interview on 8/18/21 the Residential Manager stated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CPR and First Aid training were completed online. - CPR training participants demonstrated chest compressions by clicking a computer mouse. - Sometimes the online counting mechanism skipped chest compressions/mouse clicks, thus it was difficult to know if the participant completed the appropriate number of chest compressions. - Positioning of the hands on the sternum and the depth of chest compressions were important factors in CPR; if done improperly, the victim could be injured. - Online training did not ensure appropriate hand placement or chest compression depth.
