Issue Addressed

10 A NCAC 27G .0205 Assessment and Treatment / Habilitation or Service Plan

In the issue of a missing service plan for client # 1.

A new updated service plan has been created and is being placed in that client's record. For future reference the plan will be reviewed and updated as needed by staff and the director no less than every six months. So that this problem does not occur again, in the future all staff will follow policy and create a Treatment Plan as soon as the client is authorized to reside at this facility. This problem will be elimated with staff reviewing and updating client files no less than every six months and the Director monitoring adherence to this issue.

The Director will be responsible for ensuring all procedures are followed and will review client records and staff responsibilities on an on-going basis.

Issue Addressed

10 A NCAC 27G .0207 Emergency Plans and Supplies

Instead of having fire and disaster drills as they had been done previously they will now be executed to include at least one fire and one disaster drill on each shift each quareter. This new drill procedure will document when the drill was taken and if the drill was completed In the AM or PM. The fire drill log shall be available to all staff at all times. These changes shall be effective immediately and the staff shall receive training on this procedure and the Director shall monitor compliance by all staff on a routine basis.

Issue Addressed

10 A NCAC 27G .5602 Supervised Living Staff

The group home facility will have a system in place that will always have a staff person at the group home when the consumer gets off the van that brings him home from the

day program he is attending. The consumer's guardian and the director of the group home are working on an assessmentand a plan that will allow the consumer to have a small amount of unsupervised time for one or two days per week. This will be written into his goal plan and if he does well with this amount of time, he can earn more unsupervised time in the future if he works on conpleting his goals, uses his time wisely; and follows facility rules on a routine basis.

The guardian and the group home director have already decided the amount of time we will allow initially and we will monitor this situation very closely.
