V 118	27G .0209 (C) Medication Requirements  10A NCAC 27G .0209 MEDICATION REQUIREMENTS (c) Medication administration: (1) Prescription or non-prescription drugs shall only be administered to a client on the written order of a person authorized by law to prescribe drugs. (2) Medications shall be self-administered by clients only when authorized in writing by the client's physician. (3) Medications, including injections, shall be administered only by licensed persons, or by unlicensed persons trained by a registered nurse, pharmacist or other legally qualified person and privileged to prepare and administer medications. (4) A Medication Administration Record (MAR) of all drugs administered to each client must be kept current. Medications administered shall be recorded immediately after administration. The MAR is to include the following: (A) client's name; (B) name, strength, and quantity of the drug; (C) instructions for administering the drug; (D) date and time the drug is administered; and (E) name or initials of person administering the	V 118	* Staff must double check the MAR to review all documentation has been completed at the end of each med pass, once meds are administered. The findings are:</p> <p>Review on 1/7/26 of client #3's record revealed: -Date of Admission: 1/6/26; -Diagnoses: Amphetamine-type Substance Use Disorder, Severe; Bipolar Disorder, Moderate; Cannabis Use Disorder, Moderate; Generalized Anxiety Disorder, Severe; Unspecified Depressive Disorder, Moderate; Cocaine Use Disorder, Severe in early remission by history; Alcohol Use Disorder, Severe in sustained remission per history; Tobacco Use Disorder, Severe; -Physician order dated 1/5/26 for Gabapentin 300 milligrams (mg), prescribed for pain, and Aripiprazole 5 mg, prescribed for Bipolar Disorder.</p> <p>Review on 1/8/26 of client #3's MAR for January 2026 revealed: -Gabapentin 300mg, take 1 capsule by mouth three times daily, was not documented as having been administered on 1/6/26 at 9am;</p>	V 118

Interview on 1/7/26 with client #3 revealed: -"Staff gave his medication every day and on time."  Interview on 1/8/26 with the nurse revealed: -"The medication was administered, but she forgot to initial the medication was administered."  Interview on 1/9/26 with the Regional Director revealed: -"They (Licensee) are already speaking with individuals to tighten that (medication errors) up;" -The Licensee had more agency nurses than before (the last year); -She had spoken to the Nurse Supervisor, and the nurses should be reviewing the MAR before and after passing the medication.
