- Serving only elderly (55 and older)
- Special Care Unit for Alzheimer's/Dementia
- Special Care Unit for Mental Health Disorders

Family Care Homes (2-6 beds)

Multi-Unit Assisted Housing with Services





### Percentage of Population with Alzheimer's




### Percentage of Population with MI

## Percentage of Population with ID/DD











## Comparison of Cost of Care

Homemaker/Companion Services	\$40,040
Home Health Aide	\$41,710
Adult Day Health	\$13,260
Assisted Living (private room)	\$36,000
Nursing Home (semi-private room)	\$75,190

## Staffing Requirements

 Mostly unlicensed staff performing all personal care and medication administration—no clinical skill

Quarterly nurse visits only for specific needs

 Administrator not required to be on-site until census over 81 residents

No Medical Director

## Adult Care Facility Oversight


### Division of Health Service Regulation (DHSR)

- Adult Care Licensure Section
  - Licenses and inspects ACH/FCHs
  - Administers Star Rating and Administrator Certification Programs
- Construction Section
  - Approves initial building plan and design
  - Biennial inspections of physical plant and life safety

### County Departments of Social Services

- Routine monitoring
- Complaint investigations

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

## Partnering With the N.C. Medical Care Commission: Where Do We Go From Here?

- Support recommendations of DHSR and its stakeholders in changes to statute and rule
- Explore ways to allow residents to 'age in place' safely
- Recommend holistic study of adult care industry, resident needs, appropriate staffing, funding, etc.
- Support, recommend, study ways to grow and cultivate the direct care workforce, including consideration of Just Culture concepts

- Explore ways to increase involvement of health care professionals in the assessment and care planning process
- Explore ways to improve the Star Rating program to promote quality improvement using standardized quality measures and create a more meaningful tool for consumers
- Design incentives for facilities to increase quality of programming and care of residents with dementia
- Advocate for increased resources for the ACLS to handle increased workload volume and continue to protect the health and safety of residents
