- 1 10A NCAC 14D .0213 is proposed for adoption as follows:
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3 10A NCAC 14D .0213 OUTSIDE ENTRANCE AND EXITS

- 4 (a) An adult day care program offering overnight respite care services shall have at least two exits on all floor
- 5 levels. If there are only two, the exit or exit access doors shall be so located and constructed to minimize the
- 6 possibility that both may be blocked by any one fire or other emergency condition.
- 7 (b) At least one entrance and one exit door shall have a minimum width of three feet and another shall be a
- 8 minimum width of two feet and eight inches.
- 9 (c) At least one principal outside entrance and exit for the residents' use shall be at grade level or accessible by ramp
- 10 with a one inch rise for each 12 inches of length of the ramp. For the purposes of this Rule, a principal outside
- 11 entrance and exit is one that is most often used by residents for vehicular access. If the program serves any resident
- 12 that must have physical assistance with evacuation, the building shall have two outside entrances and exits at grade
- 13 <u>level or accessible by a ramp.</u>
- 14 (d) All exit door locks shall be easily operable, by a single hand motion, from the inside all times without keys.
- 15 Existing deadbolts or turn buttons on the inside of exit doors shall be removed or disabled.
- 16 (e) All entrances and exits shall be free of all obstructions or impediments to allow for full instant use in case of fire

17 <u>or other emergency.</u>

- 18 (f) All steps, porches, stoops and ramps shall be provided with handrails and guardrails.
- 19 (g) In adult day care programs offering overnight respite care services with at least one resident who is determined
- 20 by a physician or is otherwise known to be disoriented or a wanderer, each exit door for resident use shall be
- 21 equipped with a sounding device that is activated when the door is opened. The sound shall be of sufficient volume
- 22 that it can be heard by staff. If a central system of remote sounding devices is provided, the control panel for the
- 23 system shall be located in the office area or in a location accessible only to staff authorized by the administrator to
- 24 <u>operate the control panel.</u>
