10A NCAC 13P .0605 is proposed for adoption as follows:
10A NCAC 13P .0605 ACCREDITED EMS EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION REQUIREMENTS
(a) EMS Educational Institutions who already possess accreditation by the CAAHEP may be credentialed by the
OEMS by presenting:
(1) an application for credentialing;
(2) evidence to the OEMS of current CAAHEP accreditation;
(3) a copy of the self study;
(4) a copy of the executive analysis; and
(5) documentation reflecting compliance with Rule .0602(b) and (c) of this Section.
(b) Accredited EMS Educational Institutions may offer initial and renewal educational programs for EMS personnel
as defined in Rule .0501 of this Subchapter.
(c) EMS Educational Institutions maintaining CAAHEP accreditation shall renew credentials no more than 12
months prior to expiration by providing the information detailed in Paragraph (a) of this Rule.
(d) EMS Educational Institutions that fail to maintain CAAHEP accreditation will be subject to the credentialing
and renewal criteria set forth in Rule .0602 of this Section.
(e) Accredited EMS Educational Institution credentials are valid for a period not to exceed five years.
