## **MEMORANDUM**

**DATE:** June 17, 2019

**RE:** Proposed Readoption/Amendment/Repeal of Ambulatory Surgical Facility Construction

Rules - 10A NCAC 13C

GS 150B-21.2 requires a rule-making body to notify certain individuals of its intent to adopt a rule. It also requires notification of the date, time and location of the public hearing on the rule and any fiscal analysis that has been prepared in connection with the proposed rule. At this time, five rules are being readopted as a result of the periodic review of the Subchapter 10A NCAC 13C rules, thereby requiring rules determined as "Necessary With Substantive Public Interest" be readopted as new rules. In addition, as part of the reorganization of the rules in the Physical Plant Construction Section to conform to the national construction FGI standards, three rules are being amended and two rules are being repealed.

The North Carolina Medical Care Commission has submitted form OAH 0300 to the Codifier of Rules, Office of Administrative Hearings, indicating its intent to proceed with the following rule-making actions:

Approval of the fiscal analysis for these rules was obtained from the Office of State Budget and Management on April 4, 2019 in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.4 and 150B-21.3A(d)(2). Pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.4(d), a fiscal note is not required for a repeal of a rule.

Ms. Nadine Pfeiffer, DHSR Rule-Review Manager, is accepting public comments on these rules and the fiscal analysis from June 17, 2019 – August 16, 2019. Comments will also be accepted in person at the public hearing. The proposed effective date of these rules is January 1, 2020.
