RE: Proposed Readoption of Licensing of Adult Care Homes of Seven or More Beds and

Licensing of Family Care Homes Rules: 10A NCAC 13F and 10A NCAC 13G

GS 150B-21.2 requires a rule-making body to notify certain individuals of its intent to adopt a rule. It also requires notification of the date, time and location of the public hearing on the rule and any fiscal analysis that has been prepared in connection with the proposed rule. As a result of the periodic review of the rules in Subchapters 10A NCAC 13F and 10A NCAC 13G, 97 rules determined as "Necessary With Substantive Public Interest" are required to be readopted. At this time, four rules for the Licensing of Adult Care Homes of Seven or More Beds and three rules for the Licensing of Family Care Homes are being proposed for readoption.

The North Carolina Medical Care Commission has submitted form OAH 0300 to the Codifier of Rules, Office of Administrative Hearings, indicating its intent to proceed with the following rule-making actions:

In accordance with G.S. 150B-21.3A(d)(2), a fiscal analysis was prepared for rules with substantive change. Approval of the fiscal analysis for these rules was obtained from the Office of State Budget and Management on April 29, 2019 in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.4. A fiscal analysis is not required for rules repealed through readoption in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.4.

A public hearing is scheduled for August 7, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 104, Brown Building, 801 Biggs Drive, Raleigh, NC 27603. The building is located in the Dorothea Dix Park. Ms. Nadine Pfeiffer, DHSR Rule-Review Manager, is accepting public comments on these rules and the fiscal analysis from June 17, 2019 – August 16, 2019. Comments will also be accepted in person at the public hearing. The proposed effective date of these rules is January 1, 2020.
