The attached rule-making package applies to rules 10A NCAC 13K .0102, .0401, .0604, .0701, and .1104. These rules apply to the licensure of hospices. These rules are being proposed for readoption to definitions, patient's rights and responsibilities, patient/family care plan and dietary services.

The readoption and amendment of these rules are necessary to come in compliance with federal regulations 42 CFR 418.3 that governs definitions, 42 CFR 418.60 that governs personnel, 42 CFR 418.52 that governs patient rights, 42 CFR 418.56 that governs patient/family care plan, and 42 CFR 418.110 that governs dietary services.
