SECTION .4800 - DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING

10A NCAC 13B .4801 ORGANIZATION

- (a) Imaging services shall be under the supervision of a full-time radiologist, consulting radiologist, or a physician experienced in the particular imaging modality and the physician in charge must have the credentials required by facility policies.
- (b) Activities of the imaging service may include radio-therapy.
- (c) All imaging equipment shall be operated under professional supervision by qualified personnel trained in the use of imaging equipment and knowledgeable of all applicable safety precautions required by the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Environmental Health Radiation Protection Section.
