  - 4 Each family care home shall have at least one staff person on the premises at all times who has completed within the 5 last 24 months a course on cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and choking management, including the Heimlich 6 maneuver, provided by the American Heart Association, American Red Cross, National Safety Council, American 7 Safety and Health Institute and Medic First Aid, or by a trainer with documented certification as a trainer on these 8 procedures from one of these organizations. If the only staff person on site has been deemed physically incapable of 9 performing these procedures by a licensed physician, that person is exempt from the training.
