## **Rule-making Coordinator's Certificate**

As Required by GS 150B-19.1(g)
For Proposed Permanent and Temporary Rules Adopted to
Implement a Federal Law or which upon Receipt of Federal Funds is Conditioned

The attached rule-making package applies to rules 10A NCAC 15 .1001-.1008, .1601-.1649, and .1653. These rules are proposed for readoption, amendment, and repeal for all licensees who use radioactive materials and all licensees who use radioactive materials for medical use in humans.

The readoption, amendment, and repeal of these rules are necessary to come into compliance with the federal regulations in 10 CFR 19 that governs radiation safety postings, inspections, and reports to occupationally exposed workers, 10 CFR 20 that governs health and safety requirements to protect occupationally exposed workers, minors, and members of the public from unnecessary exposure to radiation. The specific regulations being readopted and amended are:

For amendment, notices, instructions and reports to workers: 10 CFR 19.1, 19.2, 19.3, 19.5, 19.11, 19.12, 19.13, 19.14, 19.15, 19.16, 19.17, 19.18, 19.20, 19.31, 19.32.
