RE: Proposed Readoption/Amendment/Repeal of Radiation Protection Commission Rules

10A NCAC 15 .0201-.0213

GS 150B-21.2 requires a rule-making body to notify certain individuals of its intent to adopt a rule. It also requires notification of the date, time and location of the public hearing on the rule and any fiscal analysis that has been prepared in connection with the proposed rule. There are 13 rules in this rulemaking action. With input from advisory committees, working groups of the N.C. Radiation Protection Commission and stake holders, substantive changes are proposed for 10 rules for readoption with substantive changes and four rules for amendment.

The rules that are being readopted reflect agency requirements, not federal requirements. These rules are necessary because they clarify agency expectations for registrants and licensees possessing and using sources of radiation within the State. Two of the rules being amended are being amended to correct references to definitions that apply to X-Ray registrants found in one rule that is being readopted with substantive changes during this rulemaking.

The North Carolina Radiation Protection Commission has submitted form OAH 0300 to the Codifier of Rules, Office of Administrative Hearings, indicating its intent to proceed with the following rule-making actions:

Approval of the fiscal analysis for these rules was obtained from the Office of State Budget and Management on in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.4.

The proposed rule text is attached to this memo. The rules will be published in the November 15, 2024 edition of the N.C. Register which can be found at the Office of Administrative Hearings web site at https://www.oah.nc.gov/rules-division/north-carolina-register.

A public hearing is scheduled for December 11, 2024 at 10:00 p.m. in Room 026, Edgerton Building, 809 Ruggles Drive, Raleigh, NC 27603. The building is in the Dorothea Dix Park. Ms. Shanah Black, DHSR Rule-Review Manager, is accepting public comments on these rules and fiscal analysis from November 15, 2024 through January 14, 2025, close of business. Comments will also be accepted in person at the public hearing. The proposed effective date of these rules is May 1, 2025.
